### 999

Is it an emergency? Does it feel like the situation could get heated or violent very soon? Is someone in immediate danger? Do you need support right away? If so, please call **999** now.

If you have a hearing or speech impairment, use the textphone service 18000 or text on 999 if you've pre-registered with the emergency SMS service.

### 101

If the crime is not urgent but still requires reporting.
